By car – follow signs from the M20 junction 11, towards Hythe. Then follow brown tourism signs for Brockhill Country Park, which shares a joint entrance with Brockhill School.

By bus - Stagecoach run busses on route numbers 10/10A or 18 up to every 30 minutes at peak times to an (unmarked) bus stop at the entrance to Brockhill. Head to Stagecoach’s website to find out more stagecoachbus.com

By train – The nearest train station is Sandling, with hourly trains from both London Charing Cross and Dover Priory. Turn left out of the station and walk for 15 minutes along Sandling Road to our pedestrian entrance. Head to National Rails website to find out more nationalrail.co.uk

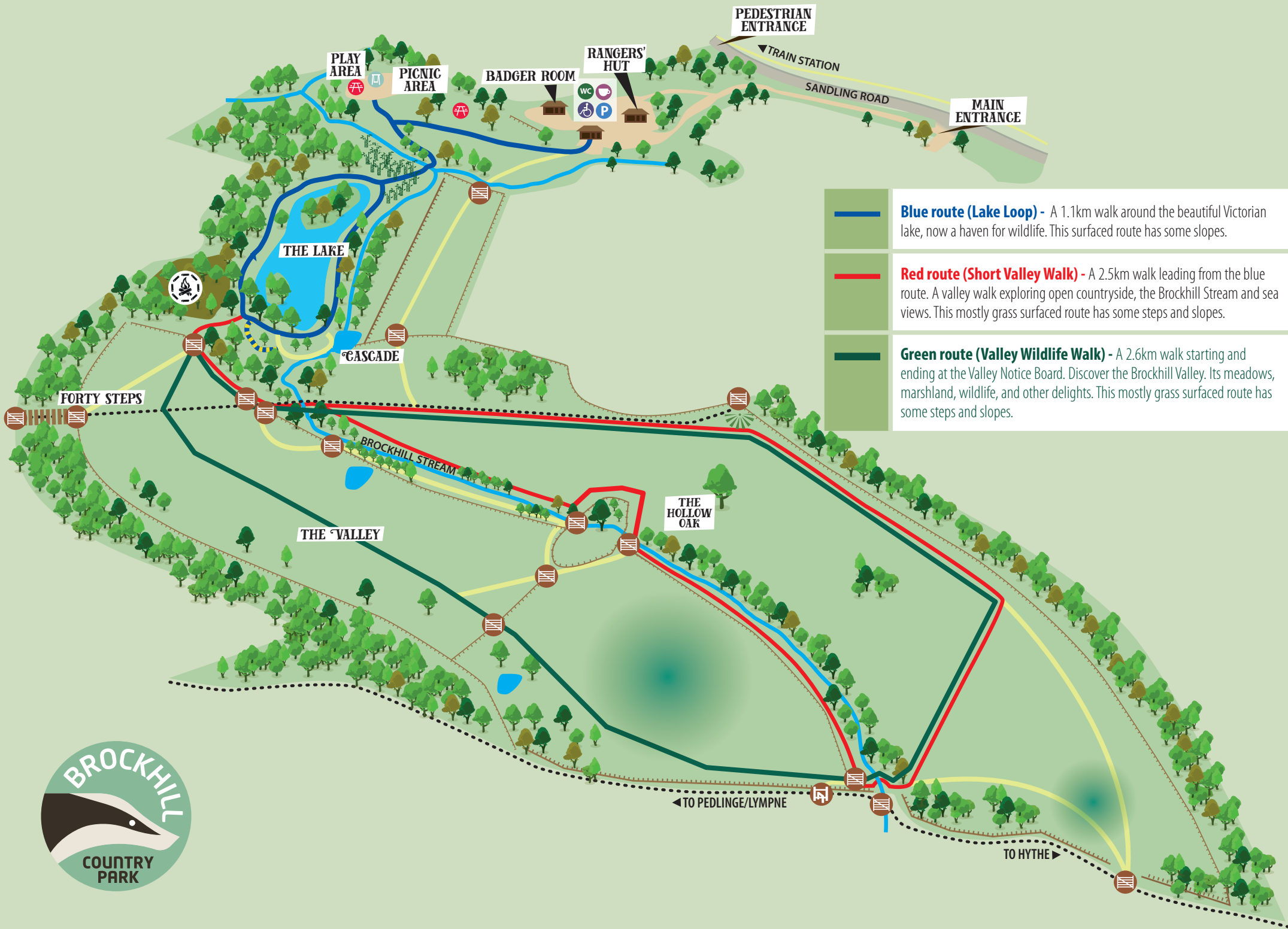

- **Blue route (Lake Loop)** - A 1.1km walk around the beautiful Victorian lake, now a haven for wildlife. This surfaced route has some slopes.
- **Red route (Short Valley Walk)** - A 2.5km walk leading from the blue route. A valley walk exploring open countryside, the Brockhill Stream and sea views. This mostly grass surfaced route has some steps and slopes.
- **Green route (Valley Wildlife Walk)** - A 2.6km walk starting and ending at the Valley Notice Board. Discover the Brockhill Valley. Its meadows, marshland, wildlife, and other delights. This mostly grass surfaced route has some steps and slopes.
