SEVENOAKS



Overflowing with atmosphere, vibrant shopping streets, architectural treasures and appealing places to eat and drink, Sevenoaks provides a taste of traditional Kentish life.


There's loads to see and do, such as visiting the impressive National Trust stately home of Knole with its exquisite galleries and seeing the herds of wild deer in Knole's surrounding parkland.

Why not take a visit to the Sevenoaks Museum, home to over 4,000 historical artifacts and artworks? Or take a wander around the Otford Solar System and discover one of the largest scale models in the world that shows just how vast space is.

Similarly the Sevenoaks Wildlife Reserve offers a lovely place to walk in the peace and quiet as you wander past lakes, birds and a vast array of diverse plants. 

WALKING ROUTES

SEVENOAKS WALK - PARKLANDS AND **PARAKEETS**

Trek through 4 miles of Knole Park and take in glorious views on your circular walk across the historic deer park and through the gates into 24-acres of manicured gardens. Look out for parakeets as these can be seen and heard above the park on your journey too.

KEMSING WALK

Take on a challenging ascent and descent of the North Downs on a 6.5-mile route passing through the beautiful village of Kemsing. The walk offers magnificent views across the Weald of Kent as you start from the fascinating village of Kemsing and pass through the church of St Mary the Virgin.


OTFORD WALK

On a 5.3-mile circular route you can find yourself marvelling at the planets in one of Kent's most attractive villages with thriving inns, restaurants and independent shops. Head high onto the North Downs for spectacular views over the countryside.

DARENT VALLEY PATH (LONG DISTANCE ROUTE)

Darent Valley Path is a long distance 19-mile linear route, following the meandering river from the banks of the busy River Thames at Dartford through the Kent Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty to the Greensand Hills above Sevenoaks.

GETTING AROUND

There are great rail and road links from the centre of London as well as the cross-Channel route via Eurostar, Eurotunnel and passenger ferries from the Port of Dover. Once you have arrived in Sevenoaks you can explore the areas around the town by either walking or hopping on a train. There are several long-distance walking trails that are great to try when exploring the area.

Travelling by foot is always a good way to explore Sevenoaks. Walking trails will help you make the most of your time here and to enjoy the winding lanes and streets, all with their own unique identity.

Leaving the car at home for some trips will save you money and reduce emissions and it's easy to travel by train to the surrounding villages. It also allows you to be active as part of your daily routine, helping you to stay fit and healthy. Take a close look at the map and see how easy it is to walk or cycle from your home to the station, school, or town centre.


NATIONAL TRUST - CHARTWELL
